This year's fellowship class regrouped students from across Yale's schools of law, medicine, public health, management, divinity, nursing, and the arts & sciences, as well as Yale College.

Innovative health law & policy Research Projects

This year's Solomon Center Student Research Fellows undertook a broad range of original health law and policy research projects, ranging from academic papers and op-eds to public policy recommendations, market research, and much more.

This year's projects touched on 12 overarching topic areas:

Each fellow was paired with a faculty expert and a small group of peers pursuing projects in the same topic area to receive feedback on their research as it evolved.

Innovative health law & policy Research Projects

Below are just a few examples of projects that Solomon Center Research Fellows undertook over the past year:

- **Kanhai Amin (Yale School of Medicine '29)** examined whether family branding for over-the-counter drugs with different active ingredients may lead to confusion and increased risk among patients and physicians.
- **Jordan Cozby (Yale Law School '26)** analyzed how legal doctrines are evolving to account for the growing role of caregivers for older adults who are not married to or directly related to an elder.
- **Laurice Oliveira (Yale School of Nursing '26)** evaluated whether health insurers in Connecticut have covered mental health and substance use disorder claims at parity with medical and surgical claims, as required by law.
- **Melissa Tempest (Yale School of Public Health '27)** designed a longitudinal study of whether and how uptake of Connecticut's paid family and medical leave program is associated with maternal and infant health outcomes.

Original and groundbreaking Research Projects

- **Kate Samuelson (Yale Law School '27)** analyzed ongoing antitrust litigation relating to health insurers' use of data analytics tools to determine out-of-network payments.
- **Isha Yardi (Yale School of Medicine '28)** investigated how to create a community advisory board for research focused on immigrant health outcomes and access across Connecticut.
- **Ahsan Ahmad (Yale School of Public Health '26)** developed policy recommendations to strengthen infectious disease care in correctional and re-entry settings.
- **Daniel Akwa (Graduate School of Arts and Sciences '29)** traced the evolution of the FDA's Accelerated Approval pathway for drugs that treat serious conditions.
- **Uma Menon (Yale Law School '27)** assessed the applicability of state consumer protection laws to non-profit hospitals.
- **Kyle King (Yale School of Medicine '28)** examined the ethics of extending medical-aid-in-dying laws to patients who only suffer from mental health conditions.

- **Kanhai Amin (Yale School of Medicine '29)** undertook transformation projects at Aledade aimed at helping physicians implement AI/ML technology to improve patient care.
- **Antigone Antonakakis (Yale School of Public Health '26)** and **Himani Pattisam (Yale School of Public Health '26)** served as co-Executive Directors of the HAVEN Free Clinic, a student-run clinic that provides free primary care services to the New Haven community.
- **Emma Bebarta (Yale School of Public Health '26)** served as a Leadership in Global Health Fellow at UNICEF, supporting their Adolescent Health team.
- **Shamik Bhat (Yale School of Medicine '26)** served as a Health Policy Intern at the Urban Institute, helping analyze the effects of H.R. 1 on Medicaid and Affordable Care Act exchanges.
