Dear Judge Haight:

As stipulated in the referenced settlement agreement, section IV.A.5., the Army Discharge Review Board (ADRB) continues to make every effort to complete its reconsideration of Group A applicants in a timely manner and agreed to provide a report every six months of the number of Group A cases reconsidered and decided.

This letter serves as the Army's fourth report to the Court regarding the status of the Army Discharge Review Board's timely review of the Group A cases under review. A breakdown of the Group A cases is as follows:

- (2) the number of Group A cases scheduled for an upcoming board,
- (3) the number of Group A cases boarded, and
- (4) a breakdown of the boarded cases, whose grant state was either full or partial relief, based on the type of characterization of service or other change made to an applicant's discharge.
