She writes on both recent and historic aspects of labor law and worker organizing, the intersection of intellectual property and the law of the workplace, free expression at and relating to work, and gender and disability discrimination. Her forthcoming books are “There Are No Neutrals There: Radical Union Lawyers in the 20th Century” (Cambridge University Press) and “Speech @ Work” (Yale University Press).
